COMMENDATION

"During the period 17 March 1967 through 15 January 1968 your performance of duty was exceptionally noteworthy. Serving as a Scout Observer, a Sergeant's billet, you performed your duties in a thoroughly competent and professional manner. Two specific occassions are indicative of your achievements throughout the period. On operation Buffalo, 3-13 July 1967, though wounded, you continued to direct artillery fire on a large North Vietnamese Army force, thus preventing it from over running the company position. On operation Cochise, 7-29 August 1967 while manning a squad size observation post, your unit was over run and forced down the hill. Upon receiving reinforcements, you led the assault to retake the position and then called artillery fire on the fleeing Viet Cong.
